

Board Term Details

Guthrie Township - Hubbard County

Township elections are held in November and are all four year terms. New or re-elected members take the oath of office on the First Monday in January following the November election.

Township Clerk: This is a four year term currently held by Russ Nickerson. Russ was elected in **2014** (Term ends 2018).

Township Supervisor A: This is a four year term that was held by Russ Nickerson who was elected in 2012. Russ was elected to Clerk in 2014 and resigned the Supervisors position to be the Clerk. Amanda Lofthus was appointed to fill the remainder of the term. (Term ends 2016)

Township Supervisor B: This is a four year term currently held by Roger Corsen. Roger was Re-elected by in 2012 by 230 votes (Term ends 2016)

Township Supervisor C: This is a four year term currently held by Michael Schmidt. Mike was Re-elected in 2014 by 167 votes (Term ends 2018)

Township Treasurer: This is a four year term currently held by Kerri Jourdain . Kerri was elected by a write vote of 26 in 2012 (Term ends 2016)

Terms of office begin on the first Monday in January following the election. The terms of the old officers in statutory cities end at this time, or as soon after that as the newly elected officers qualify by taking an oath and filing a bond, if one is required. If the newly elected officer refuses or fails to qualify, the incumbent officer continues to hold office until the council declares the office vacant and appoints a successor. The terms of all city councilmembers in charter cities expire on the first Monday in January of the year in which they expire. All officers of charter cities chosen and qualified shall hold office until their successors qualify. The length of the various terms of office is provided by statute. The attorney general has advised that a person elected to fill a vacancy is eligible to qualify and assume office upon receipt of an election certificate.

Whether or not public officials need a bond, they must take and sign an oath of office before exercising any of their powers. This includes members of councils, boards, commissions, and administrative officers. This applies to appointed as well as to elected officials.
