

The Guthrie Town board met at the town hall on January 12, 2010 at 8:00 p.m. with Russell Nickerson, Roger Corson, Amanda Lofthus and Rob Roed present. The minutes from the last meeting were read and were amended as follows: In regards to the township taking over Roxbury Drive, 100% of land owners that use this road need to approve a special assessment. The Treasurer's Report gave a balance of \$61,453.03 in the General Fund and \$3,243.55 in the cemetery fund. Receipts have been received in the amounts of \$18,014.01, 5,064.37 and \$5.88.

Russ and Roger explained the current position of the township accepting Rea Drive. Rob Roed is here for Gary Lundberg to obtain whatever paperwork is needed for full acceptance. Russ said that a legal description needs to be created and all the landowners must give permission for the road to be used through their properties. Russ would like some more time to do more research as to what else is necessary.

According to the county engineer, a stop sign should be posted at the end of a road that is not owned by the township if a resident requests one, and it is on our road's right of way. The board has also contacted the MAT attorney, and were advised the township is not required to provide stop signs on non-township roads.

Discussions concerning the picnic shelter, cemetery rules and average township salaries will be tabled until the next meeting due to Michael's absence.

The next monthly meeting will be held on February 9, 2010 at 8:00 p.m. Roger motioned to pay the bills, Russ seconded. Russ motioned to adjourn, Roger seconded the motion.
