The Town Board met at the Board Room on March 12, 2008 with all members present. The Meeting opened at 8:10 p.m. with the Pledge to the Flag. Becky Beevor visited the meeting and was looking into the Treasurer's duties.

The Minutes of the February meeting were approved after a typing error was corrected on 450 Street. The Treasurer reported a balance of \$83589.97 in the General Fund and \$4698.24 in the Cemetery Fund. The Supervisors audited the books on March 10, 2008.

The Board of Supervisors will meet with Gladen Construction, Inc. to set the road contract for the coming year. There is a road policy meeting scheduled for the meeting on April 8th, 2008. Russ Nickerson motioned to have Attorney Valen attend. Roger Corson seconded the motion.

The Board of Supervisors agreed to put the Cemetery Maintenance Job on bids. Y.O.S.G. should share the expense. The Supervisors want to meet with the Ye Olde School Ground Board to discuss the maintenance of the school grounds. The Supervisors will make up the Spec's to be published.

The Propane Furnace will not ignite. Roger Corson was chosen to contact Jeff Muller to have the furnace checked.

Russ Nickerson will contact the County Auditor to find out how to list the three Supervisor positions on the ballot which are up for election in November.

Roger Corson will contact Randy Blake on getting the Cemetery Plats updated.

The Summer Short Course will be held at the Northern Lites Convention Center on April 2, 2008 at 8:00 am.

The Board of Appeal is scheduled for April 3, 2008 at 11:00 a.m. at the Community Center/Town Hall.

The Regular April Board meeting is scheduled for April 8, 2008 at 8:00 p.m.

The Spring Road Tour is scheduled for April 19, 2008 at 8:00 a.m.
