

The Guthrie Town Board met at the hall at 8:00 p.m. on March 10, 2011 with Russ Nickerson, Roger Corson, Michael Schmidt, Rebecca Beevor and Amanda Lofthus present. The minutes from last month's meeting were approved as read. The Treasurer gave the Monthly Financial report as \$50,264.08 in the General fund, which includes \$5,251.23 of the Cemetery fund. Michael motioned to approve the reports and Russ seconded the motion

The stop sign located at 420th and 245th Avenue has been temporarily replaced. It will need another sign that meets the new reflectivity standards and will be changed in the spring. The lights that were out of order in the parking lot have been repaired.

Running power out to the picnic shelter is tabled at this time. Stephen Rogers, Ye Olde School Grounds, will be replacing the locks to the hall and will be giving the board two keys for access. Roger confirmed with a MAT attorney that to use our building fund for its' maintenance and improvements (rather than its originally intended purpose which was to purchase it) is perfectly acceptable.

John Casson has contacted Russ and Hendrickson township did approve the extinguishment of the Eastern 2/3 of Section 36 of 400th Street. The supervisors will set up a time to meet with a MAT attorney and Hendrickson Township to go over the procedures to extinguish a road.

The next regular monthly meeting is scheduled for April 5th, 2011 at 8:00 p.m. Michael motioned to pay the bills, Roger seconded the motion. Michael made a motion to adjourn, Roger seconded it.
