

The Guthrie Town Board met at the Hall on April 12, 2006 with all members present. The Meeting opened with the Pledge. The Minutes of the March meeting were approved. The Treasurer reported a balance of \$8368.47 in the Cemetery Fund and \$77,718.97 in the General Fund. Income received: Interest - Cemetery =\$3.07 and General Fund =\$34.61.

David Johnson met with the Board to discuss the Township taking over the road on his Development. After considerable discussion, Russell Nickerson will draft a letter from the Township stating the Township will take over the road as soon as the criteria is met.

Michael Schmidt motioned to pay Russell Nickerson \$15.00 per month to maintain the Web Page for Guthrie Township. Roger Corson seconded the motion.

Tim Gladen also appeared at our meeting to discuss the road contract. Russell Nickerson will work on a contract to have ready for our Road Tour on April 18, 2006 at 7:00 a.m.

Michael Schmidt will respond to Greg Hensel's letter on what Guthrie Township did in 2005 for weed control. Roger Corson is to get quotes on finishing the Town Board Room with wain scot and paint. Roger Corson is to get quotes for finishing the Cemetery fence. There have been several requests to have native trees planted in our new addition. The Board will meet with Candy Bartels on planting trees and shrubs at our May meeting.

The Alley way in the Warren Addition of the Guthrie Townsite has a garage constructed on it. The Board decided to have the parties involved petition to have the alley abandoned.

The "Woodman Hall" which was sold to William Klaus in 1998 has not been recorded. Russell Nickerson is going to check on the hall status to see why "Guthrie Township" was listed as the owner. The following discloses the minutes on this transaction: "March, 1998, William Klaus appeared at the meeting to discuss the purchase of the Woodland Hall and the lots which are owned by the Township. He will get a Deed printed for the Township Board to sign and will pay \$100.00 at the signing." "On August 6 1998, the \$100.00 check from William Klaus is being held until Supervisor Schmidt checks with the Assessor, David Johnson on the legal description of the hall property which is being sold."

Roger Corson made a motion to have Michael Schmidt check on renting a soil conditioner to fill in the ruts in the cemetery and condition the black dirt brought in and clear out the new fence pending the affidavit signed not to exceed \$300.00. Russell Nickerson seconded the motion.

Roger Corson motioned to pay the bills. Michael Schmidt seconded the motion. The Board agreed to have the Clerk purchase ink cartridges for her computer.
