

The Town Board met at the hall on April 10, 2007 with all members present. The meeting was called to order by saying the Pledge to the Flag. The Minutes of the March meeting were approved. The Treasurer reported a balance in the General Funds at 50,3408.41 and 4508.09 in the Cemetery Fund.

David Johnson agreed to check on the Tax status on the old Woodman Hall which was sold to William Klaus.

The Board will re-visit the hole in the ditch on #255S and explore getting fill from Matt Johnson.

Michael Schmidt agreed to buy a new door lock for the Town Board room to prevent anyone who rents the hall access to town records and equipment.

Michael Schmidt met with Hendrickson Town Board to discuss 400th St. The Hendrickson Board agreed to write up a "shared road agreement" for our signature.

Michael Schmidt has resigned the position as Caretaker of the Cemetery plus partial mowing of the Ye Old School Ground grass. There are several people who have shown interest in this job and they will be asked to bid.

Roger Corson motioned to pay the bills. Michael Schmidt seconded the motion.
