

Guthrie Township Board Meeting - May 9, 2006

The town board met at the hall on May 9, 2006 with all members present. The meeting opened with the Pledge. The Minutes of the April meeting were approved as read. The Treasurer reported a balance in the Township Account at \$76,038.09 and in the Cemetery Account at \$8371.54.

Mrs. Zubke brought in 260 gopher feet pairs for the bounty.

Tim Gladen and Bob Platt brought in road contracts for the coming year. After much consideration the Board showed concern if Mr. Platt's equipment could handle the project if a major storm would occur. Gladen Construction, Inc. has ample equipment to get the roads cleared under any circumstance. Russell Nickerson motioned to award the contract to Gladen Construction, Inc. Roger Corson seconded the motion. Mr. Platt was thanked for bringing in his contract bid and to come back next year.

Russell Nickerson and Roger Corson are going to fix the road signs which are down.

Tim Gladen, Michael Schmidt, Roger Corson and Russell Nickerson worked on the graveling projects on our township roads this summer. Tim Gladen is going to bring in a cost estimate at our June Meeting.

Michael Schmidt is going to attend the weed meeting in Park Rapids on May 11, 2006.

Michael Schmidt made a motion to pay the bills. Roger Corson seconded the motion.

The completion of the board room in the new addition of the Community Center was tabled. Roger Corson is going to contact Mr. Fuller and Mr. Sharp who submitted estimates for this project.

The New Cemetery Fence Project is on hold. The interested parties were concerned on removing the large limbs sticking out over the graves. Roger Corson is going to contact a Professional Tree Service Operater to remove these Pine limbs. After this is done, the interested parties will submit their bids.

Russell Nickerson is going to contact William Klaus on getting the deed recorded for the old Woodman Hall and to remove the parked cars on the street by the hall.

Michael Schmidt is going to contact Hart Lake Township Board on getting the portion of 275 Ave. S. brought up to similar condition of 275 Ave. N is. He is also going to contact Hendrickson Town Board on the shared road on 400th Street. Guthrie Township has paid all the bills to date.

Roger Corson got a call from the new owner of the Joe Theis property about having the township take over the road. Roger told him to check the procedure on the Web.

The Hubbard County Township Association will meet at Todd Township on May 15, 2006 at 8:00 p.m.

The Guthrie Board meeting is scheduled for June 6, 2006 at 8:00 at the Community Center.

There being no further business, Michael Schmidt moved to adjourn. Roger Corson seconded the motion.
