Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes  
May 2013

The Guthrie Town Board met at the town hall at 8:00 p.m. on May 21, 2013 with Russ Nickerson, Roger Corson, Michael Schmidt, Kerri Wells, Nola Nickerson and Amanda Lofthus present. The minutes from last months' meeting were recited and approved as read. The Treasurer gave the Monthly Financial report as \$48,822.80 in the General fund, which is inclusive of \$7,378.87 in the Cemetery fund. Russ motioned to approve the reports and Roger seconded the motion.

The Summer short course will take place in Walker on June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2013 from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. The 10:00 hour will cover CTAS hands on training, and 12:30-3:00 will cover more Local Board of Equalization training (supervisors need to renew their training every four years). Also, records retention and duties of office will be covered topics.

Supervisors reviewed a report received from Gladen Construction. It stated what gravel and repairs have been made in the last month of April. Russ made a motion to have Gladen Construction improve the gravel roads of 245<sup>th</sup> and 255<sup>th</sup> South by adding a 2" Class one base to them. Roger seconded the motion. Roger also contacted Gladen Construction about the frost boils found on road tour. Gladen said they could be dug out and replaced with fabric, rock, and then gravel on top. He also asked regarding the other places in the roads that need gravel. Roger will contact Gladen's and Corson's Inc. to get a gravel quote for the repairs needed. We also need a quote to replace the culvert on 255<sup>th</sup> and to install a new culvert on 444<sup>th</sup>. Roger will also inquire if they can do the ditching needed on 245<sup>th</sup> and 440<sup>th</sup>.

Michael contacted Ingalls and Erickson. Lucky said that they could roadside brush in August. He will research for another bid for comparison.

Russ identified which signs need replacing and adjustments. They will be managed as soon as possible.

Nola Nickerson is interested in taking care of the township yard work/mowing for this summer. She has accepted an hourly wage of \$15.00 per hour.

Russ built a frame for the spring pony. It is going to be installed next to the sand box as soon as weather allows.

Michael will make some calls to find a stump grinder to take out the stump in the front town hall grounds and another in the cemetery. Russ made a motion for Corson to add black dirt where needed over the hall grounds. Michael seconded the motion.

The next regular meeting will take place on June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at 8:00 p.m. Roger motioned to pay the bills, Michael seconded the motion. Russ motioned to adjourn. Roger seconded the motion.
