

September 18, 2007

The Town Board met at the hall with all members present. The Meeting opened with the Pledge. The minutes of the August meeting was approved. The Treasurer reported a balance of \$65,566.33 in the General Fund and \$5856.15 in the Cemetery Fund.

Income: General Fund - 28.00 interest Brenda Dahl paid \$80.00 toward well damage  
Cemetery - 23.89 interest on CD and 2.42 interest on checking account.

A vehicle owned by Megan McCormick struck the well on the community center property. The repair cost was \$234.50. Brenda Dahl has paid her share of \$80.00 and the balance will be turned over to the Deputy Sheriff to settle the matter with Ms. McCormick's ~~insurance~~.

Russ Nickerson Drafted a resolution against paving the Paul Bunyan Trail through Guthrie Township. It was in unanimously passed and signed by all board members to be sent to the ~~DNR~~. City of Bemidji

Roger Corson is to contact Gladen Construction Inc to fill the large hole in the ditch on 255th S and gravel the township parking lot.

Michael Schmidt is going to clean up after the tree removal in the cemetery with his Bobcat and move the pile of sand in the parking lot before the graveling for \$70.00

Russ Nickerson is going to cut off the stump in the road right of way on 245th

Roger Corson is going to contact Paul Corson to repair the culvert on 444th street which has an end crushed so water can't go through. \$700.00 was the price limit set by the board.

Motion was made by Roger Corson, seconded by Mike Schmidt to pay the bills.

The 11th District meeting is on September 26th at the Northern Lites convention center.

The October meeting of the town board will be on Tuesday, October 16th. at 8:00.

The 450th street was not in as good shape as the rest of the town roads. The citizens living along this road did not want the road bladed as often because of the dust. This will be brought up at the Annual Meeting to be changed as the board sees fit.

There is a Census meeting at the Beltrami Electric Conference room on October 22nd, 2007 from 9:30 to 3:30.

The Clerk was instructed to pick up a Fax roller cartridge and have 5 keys made for the lock on the board room.
