

The Guthrie Town Board met at the town hall at 8:00 p.m. on September 13, 2011 with Russ Nickerson, Michael Schmidt, Roger Corson, Rebecca Beevor and Amanda Lofthus present. The Treasurer gave the Monthly Financial report as \$49,118.25 in the General fund, which is inclusive of \$4,473.30 in the Cemetery fund. Russ motioned to approve the reports and Roger seconded the motion

A resolution was passed for the township to establish Roxbury Drive. An Order was also signed tonight to establish Roxbury Drive as a township road. This document will be sent to the County Recorder and the County Auditor to be filed once all the release of damages forms are obtained by the Clerk.

Clayton Bannor was requesting advice on a fence line dispute between his property and his neighbors.

Lynn Freeman had requested a copy of the paperwork that was recorded with the County Recorder for the vacation of Warren Addition.

Russ and Roger put in a new double arrow sign on 460<sup>th</sup> Street. They also relocated the turn sign and stop ahead sign on 460<sup>th</sup> Street. The culvert was lowered on 450<sup>th</sup> by Corson Inc. west of Hummerding's driveway. Roger has a bid for \$2850.00 from ProBuild for a gray storage shed. Corson Inc. may be able to move the shed for approximately \$500.00. Russ makes a motion to approve this bid. The building will be used predominately to store street signs and other building tools. Michael seconded the motion.

The fall road tour is set for September 24, 2011 at 8:00 a.m. All interested parties should meet at the town hall. The next regular meeting is October 18<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 p.m. This meeting will follow the 400<sup>th</sup> Street East Road Extinguishment for Hendrickson township that will commence at 7:00 p.m.
