

The Guthrie Town board met at the town hall on October 13, 2009 at 8:00 p.m. with all members present, Terry Clairmont and Gary Lundberg. The minutes from the last meeting were read and amended as follows: Gladen was paid \$927.00 and Hines \$1800.00 for road improvements approved as read. The Treasurer's Report gave a balance of \$43,118.71 in the General Fund and \$3,669.19 in the cemetery fund. Deposits were received in the amount of \$2.19 in interest

Terry and Gary presented a petition for the Township to take over the maintenance of Rea Drive off County Road 36 with more than enough signatures obtained. There are six built and occupied residences and three empty lots remaining. The Fall Road Tour will take place on October 25th at 8:00 and will determine its' condition at that time. The Board reviewed prices of the new signs and posts estimating approximately \$10,000.00 will be needed to complete the mandatory sign replacement. They would like to have a two-year plan in place to present to the 2010 annual meeting for review.

Northstar Drilling will be here at the hall tomorrow to check the well pump, as there is no water. Russ motioned for it to be pulled and fixed or replaced if necessary. Michael seconded the motion. Also, the lights on the relocated YOSG sign need to be repaired. Michael will call Dale Bunes for a status on graveling the remaining roads listed on the 2009 road improvements plan. Palomino drive is supposed to be bladed once a month. Roger received a call from Susan Azure-Johnson indicating that Palomino Drive has not been bladed. Roger contacted Gladen and they had indeed bladed it. Roger and Michael will be attending the training in Park Rapids for Local Board of Appeals and Equalization on October 27, 2009. The next meeting will take place on November 10, 2009 at 8:00. Russ motioned to pay the bills. Roger motioned to adjourn, Michael seconded the motion.
