

Guthrie Township Regular Monthly Meeting
October 18th 2011

The Guthrie Town Board met at the town hall at 8:00 p.m. on October 18, 2011 with Russ Nickerson, Michael Schmidt, Roger Corson, Rebecca Beevor and Amanda Lofthus present. The Treasurer gave the Monthly Financial report as \$43,558.94 in the General fund, which is inclusive of \$4373.30 in the Cemetery fund. Michael motioned to approve the reports and Roger seconded the motion

Randy Blake submitted a final bill for this year's cemetery maintenance. He will complete needed brushing by the front fence next spring, before the poison ivy is problematic. The door on the shed will probably need to be replaced next year. Randy did get information from Bob Closser who would custom design a book for placement of cemetery records. The supervisors would like a copy of the records to be kept here at the town hall as well as at the sexton's residence. Russ motioned to approve the service for \$345.00, Michael seconded the motion.

Russ and Roger took the fall road tour the end of September. Russ took care of trees fallen in the ditch on several township roads. Three places were identified that needed gravel and Roger contacted Gladen's for eight loads of gravel for their maintenance. The East side of 440th, 245 between sections 27 and 28 and the west end of 460th all needed gravel. Aprons need to be added onto the culvert on 450th, one side may be difficult or impossible to install because of an existing cable in the way. Russ made a motion that Corson adds an apron on the North side of the culvert for sure, on the south if possible. Roger seconded the motion.

Russ contacted Gladen's to include Roxbury Drive in their next rotation for road maintenance. Roger also contacted Gladen's to blade Palomino Drive. Concerning Clayton Bannor's issue with the fence and his neighbor, Michael was advised by MAT that they will have to work it out amongst themselves.

Russ did give a copy of the vacation of the Warren Addition to Lynn Freeman. The property lines were moved by the county after receiving and recording our vacation document.

Dana Fisher offered \$100.00 plus all legal fees incurred to purchase the property that surrounds the Old Woodsman's Hall. The parcel number is 09.37.02130 and is .35 acres. Russ motioned to accept this offer, Michael seconded the motion.

The next meeting will take place on Monday, November 14th, 2011 at 8:00 p.m. Roger motioned to pay the bills, Michael seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned.
