Fall Road Tour Meeting Minutes
August 2014

The Guthrie Town Board met at the town hall at 7:00 a.m. on Sunday August 24th, 2014 with Russ Nickerson, Roger Corson and Michael Schmidt present. The Meeting was opened with the pledge and the Team began the Guthrie road tour at 7:15PM.

The Township Board visited each and every road under the Townships control.

Some notable items are as follows:

We reviewed the work that was done from the recommendations made on the Spring Road Tour. The Board was very pleased with the work of Corson Inc who replaced a culvert on 410th Street. Corson Inc. will also performed some ditching work on the East side of 420th. Additionally, the ditch mowing and brushing was also inspected and again, the Board was very pleased with the outcome.

The Guthrie Cemetery was looked at and was found to be in very good condition
The street signs were inspected and found to be in good condition excepting the Dead end sign that was down on 440th Street. Russ will repair it.

Much discussion was made on the cost of gravel and how we can bet utilize the township funds for road improvements. It cost roughly 10,000 per mile to add a 2" compacted class 1 lift to our roads. We feel that the West side of 420th will be improved in 2015

Overall the Board feels that the roads in Guthrie are in outstanding shape and feel the investments in the roads each year have a very positive effect.
