Spring Road Tour Meeting Minutes  
April 30th 2017

The Guthrie Town Board held its Spring Road Tour and met at the Town Hall at 8:07 p.m. on Sunday April 30th 2017. In attendance were Russ Nickerson (Clerk), Michael Schmidt (Supervisor) and Amanda Lofthus (Chair / Supervisor) and Roger Corson (Supervisor).

The board inspected all township roads and noted the following:

As the tour progressed, it was obvious that there were many trees and rocks on many roads that needed to be removed (and thus not mentioned below). Mike made a motion to contact Mr. Steve Rogers and proceed with him to remove rocks and trees from the township roads, Roger seconded the motion.

The stop sign at the corner of 444<sup>th</sup> and Raven need to be repaired.

400<sup>th</sup> Street E: Contact Hendrickson about the removal of the minimum maintenance sign.

400<sup>th</sup> Street West: OK

410<sup>th</sup> Street: Needs some brushing.

Palomino: It looks like this road has not been graded this year. Needs follow-up with Gladens

245<sup>th</sup>: there is still an approach that was left by a logger. Mr. Schmidt stated that he would follow-up and get it removed

255<sup>th</sup> S: There is brush growing around the stop ahead sign and needs to be taken care of. May need gravel as well

420<sup>th</sup> E: Still looks thin on gravel and needs brushing

420<sup>th</sup> W, 245<sup>th</sup> and 440<sup>th</sup>: OK

255<sup>th</sup> N & 460<sup>th</sup>: Needs gravel

450<sup>th</sup>: The Board decided to remove the old culvert by Dan Rogers and to place the one right next to it in its place. Also, the cement Culvert at the west end will also be removed and have the culvert net to it put in its place as well. Culvert extensions and aprons may also be needed. After the road tour, a local 420<sup>th</sup> resident showed me two other culvert locations in which the culverts were caving in. This is a note that I have passed this information on to the Board.

275: Needs brushing and the minimum maintenance road sign removed

NEW BUSINESS:
