

RESOLUTION DELEGATING THE TIME PEOPLE ARE ALLOWED TO USE WHEN ADDRESSING THE BOARD

Any person that wants or needs to address the board at any regular meeting will be asked to do so as the "First Order of Business" as noted on the meeting agenda.

Any person addressing the board at any regular meeting or special meeting has three (3) minutes to convey their subject matter. After the person addressing the board has used their three minutes the chairman has the power granted by this resolution to stop the person from speaking any longer.

If the board needs or wants more information about the subject matter being presented, the board may ask for more information or specific details. When more information or specific details are asked for, the person addressing the board has another three (3) minutes to respond to the boards request.


If the person addressing the board refuses to stop addressing the board when asked by the chairman to do so, the chairman may call to recess the meeting and contact law enforcement to control the situation. After law enforcement arrive the meeting can be reconvened or rescheduled to a later date.

to ENFORCE This Resolution at all Regular Board Meetings.




